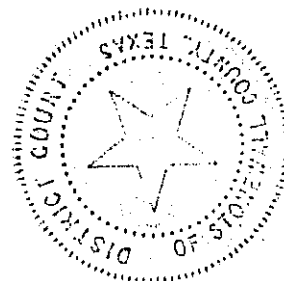
- a. Expenses of Administration, including mediator fees, ad litem fees, attorney's fees, and operating expenses.

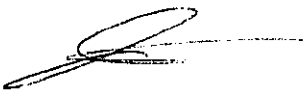

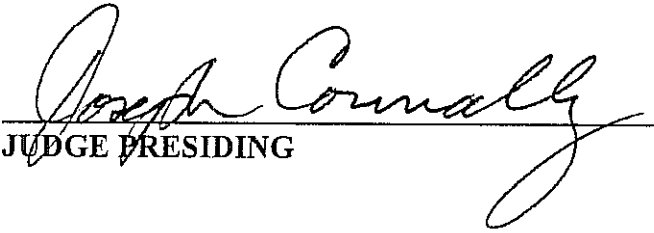
